I want to express my heartfelt gratitude for your patience and support during recent times. The weather has taken a delightful turn, and our students can now relish the beautiful November outdoors.










#### Friendly reminders

GA families must meet their financial obligations promptly. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

**5** Tuition and Fees:

Current tuition is \$8000/year for K-4th grade and \$300/month for 5th-9th grade.

Check the school's website for the tuition payment structure.

Families with multiple students enjoy a 10% optional sibling discount.

Quarterly Installment Per Student K-4th: \$2000 (Due on the first day of the quarter).

Monthly Installment Per Student 5th-9th: \$300 (Due on the first day of the month).

Discounts and Donations:

Donations are always welcome.

Each GA student is eligible for one type of discount at any given time, determined by the school administration.

\( \bigcirc \) Late Fee Notice:

Each monthly payment that is delinquent will be fined a \$25 late fee, after the 5th of every month.

Each quarterly payment that is delinquent will be fined a \$25 late fee, after the 20th of every month.










## Kindergarten October Sneak-peek





- We extend our appreciation to you for consistently cheering them on during the course.














### UICA Event
